Figure Skating is a sport that requires music to be played for competitions, tests and ice shows. Without music, our skaters could not take part in any of these events. When your child enrolls in private lessons, it becomes your obligation to participate in the music playing rotation. This is true even if your child does not have a solo. You will be scheduled to play music for each session your child skates. The number of times you will be scheduled to play music will depend on the number of skaters who are on the ice for each session. Music is played on all sessions— dance, skills, free-skate, stroking and enhancement. A schedule will be set up by our Music Coordinator.

If you are scheduled to play and cannot make it, it is your responsibility to find a replacement. A list of contact information for the parents who are scheduled for each session will be provided to you at the start of the season. *Please remember to keep this list confidential.*

\$150.00 MUSIC OBLIGATION BOND

A post-dated cheque (Music Obligation Bond) for \$150.00 is required from ALL skaters taking private lessons, regardless of the number of sessions being purchased. This cheque must accompany the registration form, (one post-dated cheque per family) in order for your child to be registered with Skate Canada and to be able to participate in skating. Once your commitment has been fulfilled, your post-dated cheque will be returned to you or destroyed. Your post-dated cheque will only be cashed if your obligation has not been met.

Exceptions: Out of Club Skaters, who pay 25% higher cost in lieu of the bond. Club skaters who are 18 years of age or older, may choose to pay a 25% higher cost in lieu of playing music.

I understand my \$150.00 Music Obligation Bond cheque, dated March 1, 2018 will only be cashed if I *do not* fulfill my music playing hours.
